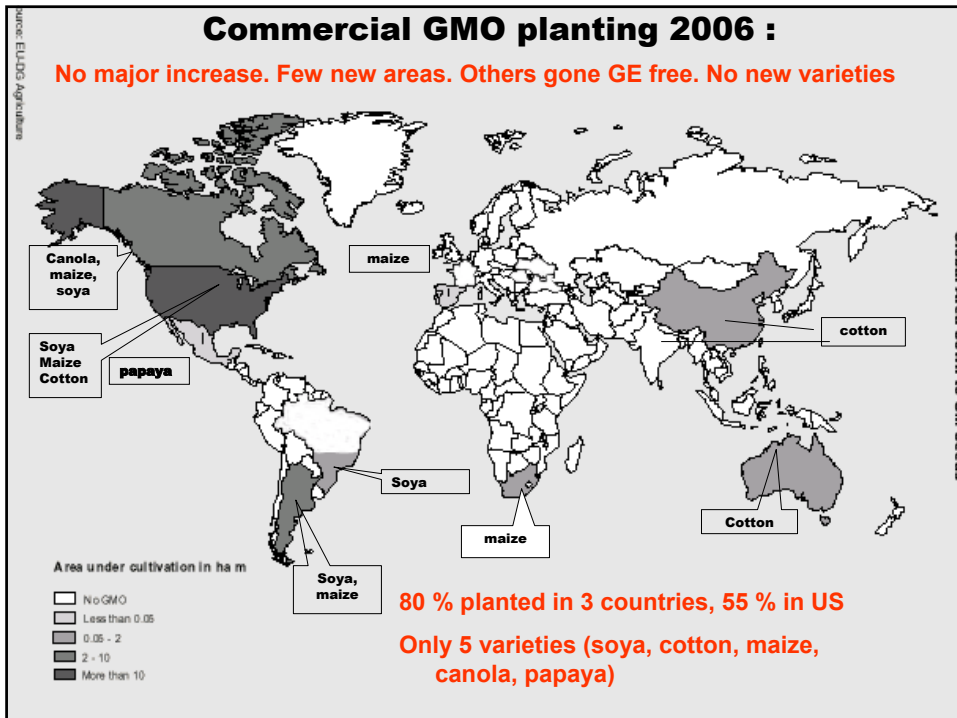

Commercial GMO planting 2006 :

No major increase. Few new areas. Others gone GE free. No new varieties



Key campaign successes 2006

- **Commercialisation of GM rice halted globally**
- **Biosafety Protocol: terminator technology stopped**
- **EU: Ministers support the right to ban GM crops**
- **Mexico: Monsanto barred from planting GM corn**

Key campaign successes 2006

- **Romania: GM soya growing banned**
- **Thailand: GM papaya halted**
- **Russia: Feed importers go GM free**







Overarching campaign goals 2007-2010

- **Safeguard biosafety and foodsecurity**
- **Stop and prevent releases of GMOs into the environment**

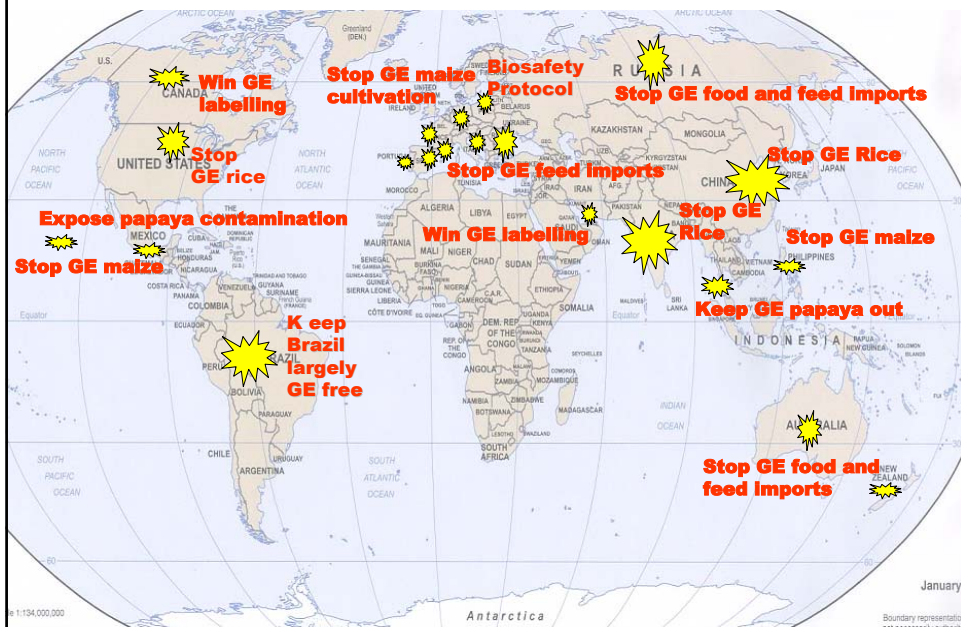
Key Battlefields (1)

- **Stop GM food and GM feed imports globally**
- **Protect centres of crop origin and crop diversity**
- **Expose and fight back GM contamination**
- **Strengthen Biosafety Protocol**

Key battlefields(2)

- Stop commercial introduction of GM rice
- Keep Brazil largely GM free
- Prevent commercial GM maize cultivation in Europe
